COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES:

Chemistry- Position requires a Master's Degree in Chemistry or related field (at least 18 graduate level credits in Chemistry).

Physics- Position requires a Master's Degree in Physics or related field (at least 18 graduate level credits in Physics).

French-Position requires a Master's Degree in French Language or related field (at least 18 graduate level credits in French).

Biology- Position requires a Master's Degree in Biology or related field (at least 18 graduate level credits in Biology).

Environmental Science- Position requires a Master's Degree in Environmental Science or related field (at least 18 graduate level credits in Environmental Science).

Math- Position requires a Master's Degree in Math or related field (at least 18 graduate level credits in Math)

COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND FOOD SCIENCE: (Adjoint Faculty for one year)

Agricultural Engineering- Position requires a Master's Degree Agricultural Engineering or related field.

Animal Science – Position requires a Master's Degree in Animal Science or related field.

COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

Nursing - Position requires an RN Certification that is honored by the Liberian Board of Nursing and Midwifery to practice in Liberia; the successful candidate must be a mid or senior level faculty with a Master's Degree in Nursing plus experience in teaching and clinical practice at the University or College level.

COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY:

Computer Science- Position requires a Master's Degree in Computer Science/Computer Systems or Communication Systems or related field (at least 18 graduate level courses in computer science).

Software Engineering/Cybersecurity- Position requires a Master's Degree in Software Engineering/Cybersecurity or related field (at least 18 graduate level courses in software engineering/cyber security).
